Position: Surgical Technician

Status: Hourly x Salaried Exempt Non-exempt x

Reports to: Charge Nurse

Purpose: Under the direction of a Registered Nurse is responsible for assisting

surgeons, anesthesiologists, and nurses in the care of patients in the operating room. Will be required to assist in other areas. Performs

other duties as assigned.

Functions:

All functions are essential unless otherwise noted.

- A. Maintains knowledge and practice of aseptic technique.
- B. Assists the circulating nurse in preparation for the surgical procedure and during turnovers between procedures.
- C. Prepares sterile field for surgical procedure, ensuring proper instruments and supplies are available for use.
- D. During the surgical procedure:
 - 1. Anticipates needs of surgeon and the passing of instruments and supplies.
 - 2. Functions as assistant when needed.
 - 3. Obtains counts with circulating nurse.
 - 4. Cares for specimens according to procedure.
- E. Maintains equipment, supplies, and environmental safety.
- F. Maintains knowledge of current trends in surgical procedures and instrumentation.
- G. Participates in in-services, committees, etc.
- H. Functions as preceptor to new employees.
- Performs additional duties as assigned.

Working Conditions:

- A. Potential for exposure to blood borne pathogens and other infectious diseases.
- B. Extensive walking, standing, lifting, pulling, and pushing associated with patient care.
- C. Potential for chemical exposure.
- D. Unpredictable mealtimes; breaks are scheduled around patient needs.

Qualifications:

- A. High School diploma or GED
- B. Certification recommended.
- C. Completion of accredited course in surgical technology or prior experience as Surgical Technician. Scrubbing experience in appropriate specialties.
- D. Skilled in utilizing a variety of surgical equipment and instrumentation.
- E. Interpersonal skills to effectively and appropriately communicate with patients, families, physicians, and co-workers.
- F. Able to demonstrate the knowledge and skill necessary to provide care based on physical, psychosocial, educational, safety and related criteria, appropriate to the age of the patients cared for, which range from infants to the elderly.
